LEGO CLUB

For small and big children !

Join us at EFL! The budding engineers and builders, girls and boys, are invited to join the club to develop their curiosity and creativity and meet new challenges every week, with the construction of LEGO EDUCATION **mechanisms, machines and robots**. **Explore and discover science, technology and robotics while playing!**



For the youngest (5-6 years old), we explore the world of construction and mechanics with the program **Early Simple Machines**.

From 7 years, we create more complex models, and see with joy how they come alive with the program **Simple and Powered Machines**.



For older children (8 years old and up) we start building and programming our first robots with the program **WeDo 2.0**.

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DISCOVERY OF THE 5 SENSES (TPS, PS, MS)

Led by: Juliette Dubreucq

This club, reserved for our youngest pupils, is designed to develop and refine the sensory faculties through diversified and motivating situations that allow them to discover various sensations.

MUSICAL AWAKENING CLUB (MS, GS, CP)

Led by: Maša Jazbec

We all know how music can be playful at any age. But music is much more than a simple leisure activity; it is also a way to develop child's mind and body in a pleasing harmony. The workshop's goal is to initiate the children to music by singing songs of all continents, lullabies, playing with nursery rhymes, presenting all kinds of instruments and by introducing several games (imitation, gesture, mime, notes, and rhythms). In other words, musical awakening enables to stimulate children's creativity and curiosity.

PUPPET CLUB (PS, MS, GS)

First steps into the world of puppets and puppetry! During this workshop, your child will discover all kinds of different types of puppets and learn how to make his own puppets. The puppet will be considered as a unique approach to developing imagination and use of language. Allow your child to have fun simply by animating his own creation and bringing his puppet to life. The workshop's goal is to introduce the children to the wonderful world of puppets and to show them how to create and perform their first puppet play.

VISUAL ARTS (PS, MS, GS)

Led by: Juliette Dubreucq

By experimenting with different materials and techniques, children will discover the possibilities and the importance of artistic expression. Through exploration of different art work, artist and art practices from all over the world, children will sharpen their view on art.

GREEN CLUB - garden, ecology, protection of environment ... (MS, GS, CP, CE1)

Led by: Juliette Dubreucq

The French School, associated to the French Nature Protection Network, offers a Green Club that will raise awareness for the protection of the environment. It will allow children to develop their knowledge about the nature also by fun activities on the school garden: sowing, planting, tillage, harvesting, tasting and processing of crops. Children learn to work in groups, to divide tasks, to think long-term about their actions on the garden, to take into account failures and to learn from them, while having the pleasure of seeing the fruit of their work grow.

BALL GAMES (PS, MS and GS, CP, CE1)

Led by: Christophe Gressier

This club offers to the younger children the opportunity to play different ball games throughout the year in a large gymnasium of the Livada primary school. The goal of the club is to enable the child to develop the motor skills necessary for the practice of a team sport.

MULTISPORT (CE2+)

Led by: Christophe Gressier

This club offers to the older children the opportunity to carry out various sports activities throughout the year in a large gymnasium of the Livada primary school. The aim is to introduce children to the practice of multiple team sports (basketball, handball, football, baseball) and traditional games.

BASKETBALL (CP+)

Led by: Jaro Samobor

Students will learn the basics of basketball, how to lead the ball, make passes, throw the ball into the basket and the rules of the game, while emphasizing the collective aspect of the game. To learn, automate and coordinate the necessary movements for the game, we will use various games.

DANCE 1 - FOR KINDERGARTEN (PS, MS, GS) *

*The club will be held in English and/or Slovene.

Led by: Nataša Beltran

The youngest dancers will learn the basics of movement on music and coordination of the body in space through games and musical tales. Each session is composed of a simple warm-up, dance and movement games and learning of choreographies. The goal of the club is for children to enjoy moving and dancing, gain orientation in space, improve their balance and flexibility, learn to listen and follow different rhythms, cooperate with each other and develop motor and creative skills.

DANSE 2 (CP+)

Led by: Nataša Beltran

Dancing class for elementary school pupils consists of dancing warm-up, dance-movement games and learning of dance choreographies. Within dancing classes pupils learn how to master different dancing rhythms, develop balance, strength and coordination of their body in space. Dancers learn how to collaborate and how to develop their individual dancing expressions. Dancing programme includes learning of several dancing styles, hip-hop, jazz ballet, Latin-American dances (salsa, samba, cha-cha-cha) and classic dances (e.g. English Waltz). Pupils are introduced to different styles of dancing and music as well as different dancing cultures based on geographical locations of their origins.



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ENGLISH (GS+)

Led by: Urša Lampret

The English Club has the main objective of developing basic language skills, focusing mainly on the necessary abilities to learn English. The lessons will be divided into two main parts. Firstly, we will work on the basic vocabulary (alphabet, numbers, colours) and on the vocabulary divided by different topics (fruits, vegetables, farm animals, weather, ...). We will be using several methods of comprehension and oral interaction (listening, repetition, memorization, graphic material). Finally, the activities and group games (board games, songs, role plays, manual activities) will conclude the lessons. This club will allow your child to learn English and discover a new culture in a natural and fun way.

THEATRE (CP+)

Led by: Maša Jazbec

The universe belongs to those who know how to observe, understand, play and love! The theatre is only one of many creative methods of learning how to observe and interact with the world. The theatre play as an artistic approach can effectively contribute to your child's full development and help him to open up in front of himself, others and the world. During this workshop, we will be trying to play by using different theatre techniques, by discovering verbal and non-verbal ways of expressing, by learning how to communicate and work as a team and by inventing our own stories, of course!

GUITAR (CP+)

Led by: Janez Premk

Teaching the guitar to several children in small groups is not an easy thing but Janez always succeeds in getting the best of his students. It is a club that needs to be continued at home for the children to progress. Janez can help the parents track children's learning.

FRENCH (6–9 years, 10–14 years)

Led by: Anne-Claire Pommier

The target audience for this club are former pupils of the French school. This club will maintain their level of French and keep them in touch with the French language, through various fun activities. As far as possible, this club will prepare students for DELF certifications.
